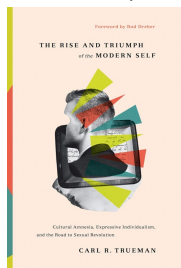

Expressive Individualism – belief that each person must act based on expressing his or her core feelings and desires



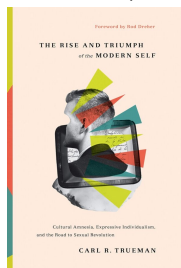
